COURSE DESCRIPTION: Al-Qaeda Doctrine and Related References will examine the full range of Jihadist tradecraft from the recruitment of members, to intelligence and surveillance practices, to establishing safe havens and training venues, and to committing acts of violence. The workshop explores the manual as a foundation for understanding Al-Qaeda and then surveys the various sources of jihadist terrorist doctrine through to the current day.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

- ❑ Develop an in-depth understanding of the Al-Qaeda Training Manual & Other Doctrinal Sources used by Al-Qaeda and their affiliates
- ❑ Examine the Al-Qaeda Manual and other sources
- ❑ Identify Radical Islamic Terrorist Tactics, Techniques & Procedures in Your Community
- ❑ Critically examine potential Pre-Incident Indicators (PIIs) from various doctrinal components of the Al-Qaeda Manual (ref. the Manchester document) and more recent doctrinal references
- ❑ Examine Al-Qaeda Security Planning and tactical operations (ref suicide bombers)
