This course is designed to teach the history/theory of homicide bombers and the response of the arriving officers to the scene of a pre-blast or post-blast suicide bombing incident (to include many other incidents of persons with bomb/explosives). The goal is to specifically give responding officers the information and skills to protect themselves and others during most bomb incidents involving active bombers.
