Training Objectives

1. Identify Biblical foundations for law enforcement ministry.
2. Examine the value of law enforcement officers and law enforcement chaplains.
3. Develop crisis communication techniques.
4. Identify stressors unique to law enforcement officers and families.
5. Identify positive and negative coping skills.
6. Examine appropriate ministry during line-of-duty-death incident.
7. Review legal liability and confidentiality.
8. Discuss sensitivity with diverse populations.

Course Prerequisites

1. Either actively serving as a law enforcement chaplain or retired/active duty law enforcement
2. Approved BGEA Applicant
3. Letter of recommendation from agency head (Police Chief, Sheriff, etc.)
