**Friday October 11th, 2019 Vista, CA**

*On February 14, 2018, the communities of Coral Springs and Parkland were impacted by the ninth deadliest mass shooting event in U.S. history and the third deadliest school shooting to date. A school shooter entered Marjory Stoneman Douglas (MSD) High School and opened fire with a long rifle.*

*Within approximately 7 minutes, 34 people were killed or injured.*
